We would like to start and maintain friendship with your organization for mutual benefit and for promoting US-Republic of Korea (South Korea) relations. We have been very impressed by your expertise, dedication, energy and presentations on South Korean political issues.

The Korean High School Alumni Alliances in North America (KHAA-NA) organization promotes a strong alliance between Americans and Koreans in the spirit of the US-ROK alliance over the last 70 years. One of the key missions of KHAA-NA is to act as a bridge between Koreans and U.S. citizens. The KHAA-NA was recently formed by senior members of Korean high school alumni organizations in the United States. We represent a group of patriotic American citizens.

One issue that we hoped to raise to your attention is the April 15, 2020 general election in South Korea. We hope this election is being closely watched by the U.S. government, members of the press, and academia. In this letter we would particularly like to highlight research by University of Michigan professor, Professor Walter Mebane, who observes anomalies in the vote counts. Another issue is about Korean lawmaker-elects Mr. Tae Young-Ho and Mr. Ji Sung-Ho who defected from N. Korea. They were sued by a leftist organization in Seoul alleging misinformation of the death of Kim Jung-Un. The leftist organization did not sue CNN or other US Mass media that reported similar information. Subsequently, the Korean Prosecution Service, a part of the Department of Justice, began

an investigation on them. We believe that this investigation is aimed to suppress voices of those who oppose the government. Also, we are very concerned that their morale would be severely diminished for the coming years in politics. Indeed, South Korea is at a crossroads because of controversies related to the recent April 15 Korean congressional election. We feel urgent that manual counting of votes is of utmost importance to verify fair elections in South Korea. Not only should the South Korean government have an internal effort of accountability, but international pressure is required to urge fair elections, especially with ROK as a democratic ally of the U.S.

We strongly recommend a recount through manual vote counting via maintaining ballot boxes, computer hardware/software and HDD via the court system. They need to resolve the issues by May 15 that is 30 days after Election Day, April 15.

South Korea has been a success model of democracy and market economy in Asia and other parts of the world. Western allies should be proud of democracy in South Korea.

Please help us protect S. Korea from falling under communist N. Korea and China.
